EIF Lesson Plan

Target: ESL elementary students, beginners level

Duration: 50 minutes

General description of the course:

- Language Point: Basic imperatives and giving instructions an advice
- Language Skills: Beginning Comprehension & Grammar

Students Learning Outcomes (SLOs):

- By the end of the lesson, students will be able to use and understand imperative in a polite or commanding way by completing the grammar activity.
- By the end of the lesson, students will be able to read a passage in the given content.
- By the end of the lesson, students will be able to correctly speak imperatives in a sentence and be to use it in a hotel.
- By the end of the lesson, students will be able to identify the imperatives in a sentence.

Rationale

- Activity 1: Ss will learn about imperatives. After the Ss learned about imperatives, They will be able to use in their day to day lives.
- Activity 2:. T will hand-out a dialogue worksheet to Ss and pair up into groups to practice reading the different roles. Check their understanding of the content by asking them to identify the verbs have been used in the dialogue
- Activity 3: Ask students to fill in the blank using the verbs to create an imperative sentences.
- Activity 4: Help Ss distinguish between the polite forms and impolite form of imperative, so Ss know when to use it.
- Activity 5: Ss will be able to use imperatives to respond to the prompts by using the flashcard.
